Why Does it Matter for Your Community?

What are On-Demand Orders?

On-demand refills are reordered as needed, not automatically.

Potential Challenges:

- Increases the chance of not having authorized refills on time for your residents
- Checking in medication daily
- Minimal medication administration accountability
- Staff responsible for reordering all medications
- Increases the chance for medication errors
- Increases the chance of medication shortages
- Decreases staff efficiency and takes time away from resident care

What are Cycle Fill Orders?

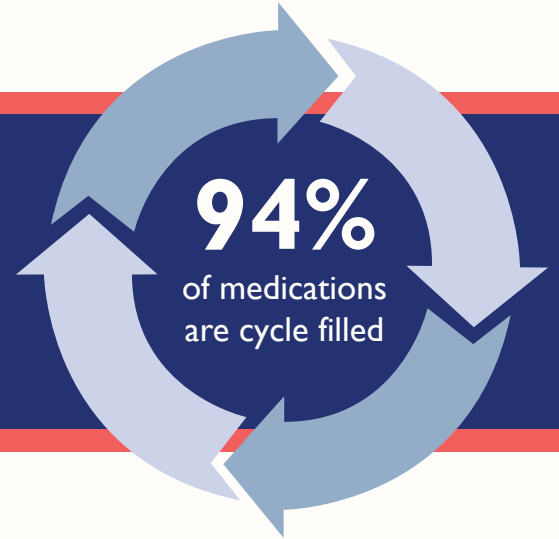
Medications that are automatically filled by the pharmacy and delivered to your community, no refill request or action is needed.



Examples of Cycle Fill orders:

- A prescription that is scheduled to be administered at a specific time. (*not a PRN*)
- A prescription with a dosage form that allows for calculating exact usage for a specific day supply, for example, capsules, tablets, inhalers, patches, eye drops, insulin, etc.

Cycle filling medication is convenient and efficient for both your staff and residents. Medicine arrives at the same time every month. Cycle fill can help your staff with medication management.
